Since the 1996 GT/CS Registry book, so much has happened in the "GT/CS World".... especially with the return of the new, 2007/2008 Mustang GT/CS. *The enthusiasm for this well-loved limited edition Mustang seems to be never-ending!*

This mailing is about an upcoming new, revised limited edition of my 1989 book: **"GT/California Special Recognition Guide and Owner's Manual"** that is slated for availability early next year. For the past two years, amazing sales on EBAY of my 1989 (@\$280) and 1996 (@\$150) editions prompted me to bring out a second edition. Great interest and support for this book has been overwhelming. It will answer the needs of maintenance, restoration, and history, as well as list all the newly registered GT/CS Mustangs since the 1996 edition (some with complete restorations!). This is a book that you've been wanting for a long time, covering more material in greater detail than the previous two books. Publishing this new edition will require licensing from Ford, approval from the Shelby American Automobile Club (SAAC), and approval for the GT/CS Concours Guidelines from the Mustang Club of America (MCA). All of these approvals are currently "in the works"; and moving along well.

This new, 2008 anniversary edition will be hardbound this time with 200 black and white and color pages, with a special DVD. This will be a quality product that will compliment your GT/CS, adding to it's value and heritage. Some owners have already expressed interest in buying more than one copy, as an investment. Selected numbers of this edition will be sold on a first-come basis. I will sign and number each of the 2000 copies in this limited printing (see the enclosed book reservation form for details on ordering). *There is no obligation to pre-order.
